Visa information:

Citizens of most Western countries can purchase visa at the airport upon arrival. The list is posted on the following AFM website but please verify this information with your local authorities:

You have to pay upon arrival and the best is to bring the exact amount of USD in cash and it is usually 25 USD. If you pay in other currencies the exchange rate is very bad.

On arrival you need to queue first to pay for your visa and then head to the immigration counter. If you already have a visa, then head straight to the immigration counter. (Thus, you might want to consider obtaining a visa before your departure!)

When leaving Indonesia there might be an airport tax in the value of 150,000 Rp/person which must be paid in cash in local currency!

Airport Transfers

Ngurah Rai International Airport (the only airport in Bali) is about 15 km from the hotel. Transfer rates are:

- Toyota Innova at IDR 150,000 per vehicle per way (includes VAT)
- Toyota Alphard at IDR 300,000 per vehicle per way (includes VAT)
- Mercedes Benz from IDR 300,000 per vehicle per way (includes VAT)

Post-Conference Sightseeing Program	
<p><i>Taman Ayun Temple is a very beautiful Hindu temple uniquely designed with a distinctive style of Balinese architecture and surrounded by a large of fishpond that looks like floating on the water. Ogoh-ogoh are statues built for the Ngrupuk parade, which takes place on the eve of Nyepi day in Bali. Ogoh-ogoh normally have the form of mythological beings, mostly demons.</i></p> <p><i>Tanah Lot is a rock formation off the island of Bali. It is home of a pilgrimage temple, the Pura Tanah Lot sitting on a large offshore rock, which has been shaped continuously over the years by the ocean tide.</i></p> <p><i>Pura Luhur Uluwatu is a Balinese sea temple standing atop a sheer cliff rising two hundred feet above the Indian Ocean. The temple commands a wonderful view of the sea breaking against the base of the cliffs below and a totally unforgettable sunset.</i></p> <p><i>„Kecak” is derived from an old Balinese ritual called the saghyang – a trance dance driven by its participants’ repetitive chanting.</i></p> <p><i>After a day tour participants will taste the flavor of Balinese sea food with great environment of beachfront view at Menega Restaurant Jimbaran.</i></p> <p><i>Expected arrival to the hotel is around 20:30.
